Attention Dog Owners



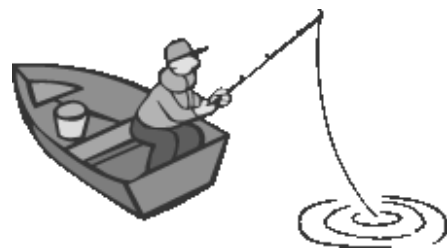

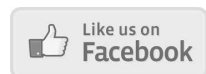
